CHILDREN, YOUTH & FAMILY

God is growing the faith of our families through the renewed energy and quality of our Children and Youth ministries.

- Visit Club WOW on Sunday morning and you’ll see children in action, learning the stories and lessons of our faith from our volunteer teachers and leaders Jessica and Janeen. Our Tuesday Power UP! children’s youth group will focus on serving others as they learn about being the hands and hearts of Christ to others. This summer our VBS program served over 80 children from Rejoice and our community.
- Mike and our volunteer mentors have an exciting vision to grow our youth ministry to reach the many young people in Mill Creek, Geneva, and surrounding neighborhoods. Matrix and Summit now include a meal and are built around small groups and growing relationships.



WORSHIP

Most people first experience Rejoice through our unique worship. Every week Patrick, Marco and the Rejoice Worship Ensemble lead through powerful music and media as Pastor Lou’s brings the Word and Sacrament to all of us. People experience God! They also experience the welcoming love and hospitality that invites them to keep coming.



MISSION & SERVICE

God works through our missions to bless and help our neighbors nearby and far away. For example, Rejoice volunteers serve the homeless at Hesus House every other month, and our Mission on the Bay celebrates a 8-year relationship with our neighbors in Slidell, LA and Biloxi, MS.
